

> How to configure LAN Settings in Windows Vista

- 2. In Control Panel, select Network and Sharing Centre.




2. Network and Sharing Centre

From Network and Sharing panel, go to Manage Network Connections.




3. Manage Network Connections


In Manage Network Connections window double-click on Local Area Connection.




4. From 'Local Area Connection Status' Dialog Box, select 'Properties'.
